Xtreme Zero Waste have had some incidences where used animal hyper dermic needles have been left at the Te Uku Recycle Drop Off Centre. This is EXTREMELY hazardous for our guys, and has the potential to cause serious harm. All used medical equipment MUST be disposed of correctly and should never be put out with household rubbish and recycling.

The proper disposal of animal hyper dermic needles is to contain them in a pre-paid bin purchased through Anexa (Raglan Vets, Bow Street). Once the bin is full you return it to Anexa for disposal through Medic Waste.
