Head Lice

Last week when I met with our new Health Nurse, Michelle Anderson, I asked her about any new ideas for treating head lice. She suggested all of the usual remedies as well as mentioned the effectiveness of hair straighteners in getting rid of the nits (eggs). If there is a headlice outbreak at school, we will send home a letter and a Ministry of Health information pamphlet on treating headlice with each child in the class concerned. Please notify the school if you discover your child has headlice. The Ministry of Health recommends the following steps in minimising an outbreak of headlice: check your children's hair every week; brush hair every evening to reduce headlice numbers; treat using a shampoo from the chemist and repeat again. We have enclosed a pamphlet for your interest this week.

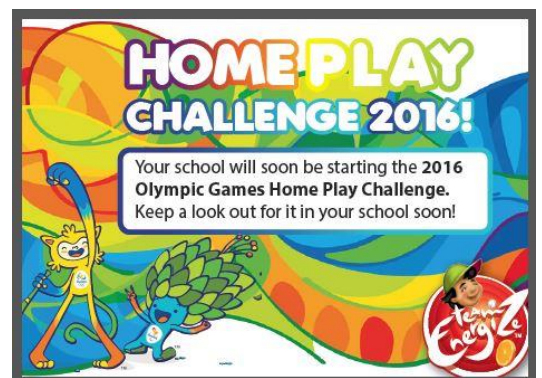
