... learn more about our focus to help children 'learn how to learn'

### 3:00 to 3:30: the classroom spaces (while your children enjoy playing outside)

... return to either the Senior Discovery or Junior Discovery classroom space so teachers can explain specific aspects of the learning programme to you

### 3:30 to 4:00 SOCIALISING TIME!!

... join staff and parents for afternoon tea in the staffroom

### 6:30 to 7:00: visit the Junior Discovery

... teachers and Rachel will demonstrate how this learning space is used to promote collaborative and student-driven learning for Years 1 to 4 children

### 7:00 to 7:30: visit the Senior Discovery

... teachers and Rachel will demonstrate how this learning space is used to promote collaborative and student-driven learning for Years 5 to 8 children

... join staff and parents for supper in the staffroom

## Scholastic Books

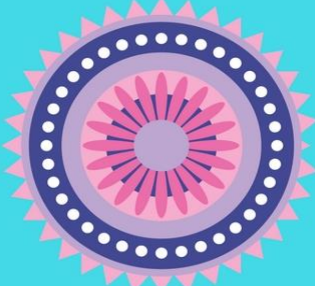

## FLIPT

Surfside Church is running their FLIPT programme for primary school age children for again this year. This is a fun programme with games, craft and some values based teaching via DVD. The children will also receive a healthy snack on arrival. It will run once a week on a Wednesday afternoon for 6 weeks starting Wednesday 21st February until Wednesday 28th March, finishing just before Easter. Start time is 3.00pm and finishing at 4.15pm when parents may collect their children. It is to be run at the Surfside Church facility at Te Uku.
